One of the objectives of the Association is to promote and facilitate the exchange of students. Institutions that have courses taught in English during regular semesters agreed to waive tuition and other fees from the host institution. Financial assistance from the Association comes in the form of an airfare and living allowance subsidy.

Each member institution is entitled to have a maximum of two (2) slots under the scheme in each semester.
