Article 1: CJCU is mandated to establish the "Chang Jung Christian University Bachelor's Degree Early Graduation Regulation" (hereafter "the Regulation") pursuant to the University Act to enable Bachelor's students to undertake early graduation.

Article 2: Any undergraduates in any school system who meet the following criteria may apply for early graduation by one semester or one academic year:

1. Before the current semester, the time to apply for early graduation, have an overall grade point average of 80 or higher and an overall grade point average ranking in the top 10% among students in the class ; If the number of students in that grade of the department is less than 10, the overall academic grade average must be ranked first.
2. Completed the required courses and credits with passing grades, and meet the various graduation requirements set by the various departments.
3. Have an operational grade of 80 or higher for each semester.
4. Students applying for early graduation who fail to meet the preceding criteria 2 and 3 at the end of the semester in which they expected to graduate shall not graduate early.

Article 3: Students who have completed the graduation credits of the department but have failed to meet the preceding criteria for

early graduation must remain enrolled.

Article 4: The application time is as follows:

Those who intend to graduate one semester ahead of schedule should apply in the first semester of the fourth grade; those who intend to graduate one semester ahead of schedule should apply in the second semester of third grade.

The application time must be based on CJCUCalendar, after the deadline will not be processed.

Article 5: The application should be proposed in accordance with administrative procedures and be agreed by the Department. After that, it should be reviewed and be approved by the Office of Academic Affairs.

Article 6: This Regulation shall be announced and be implemented upon approval by the Administrative Meeting and the University Affairs Meeting and submitted to the Ministry of Education for future reference; the same shall apply to any amendments.
