**Article 1:** Chang Jung Christian University (hereafter "the School") has established this Honorary Doctoral Degree Conferral Regulation (hereafter "the Regulation") to honor people with outstanding academic, cultural, or social group achievements or contributions pursuant to the Degree Conferral Law promulgated by the Ministry of Education.

**Article 2:** Any domestic or foreign personnel with any of the following conditions may be an honorary doctoral degree conferral candidate:

1. Special academic or professional achievements or contributions that can benefit mankind.
2. Major contributions to cultural or academic exchanges or world peace.
3. Special or major contributions to this School.

**Article 3:** Honorary doctoral degree candidates shall be recommended in writing by the Dean of the doctoral program for the School, the Board of Directors, or the Presbyterian Church in Taiwan to the President of the University.

The recommendation shall specify the name, gender, date of birth, nationality, education background, experiences, title of degree to be conferred, and the conditions specified by Article 2 of this Regulation for the candidate in detail.

**Article 4:** Candidacy for honorary degrees at the University shall be handled in accordance with the following procedures:

1. The University shall convene an Honorary Doctorate Review Committee. Said Committee shall be composed, on a case by case basis, of the University president (as chair), the Dean of Academic Affairs, the Dean of Research and Development,

the Secretary-General, the deans of all colleges, the director of the department the doctorate is to belong to, as well as five to seven professor representatives appointed by the University president and upstanding members of the public also appointed by the University president. The review committee must have at least two-thirds of members present to begin a meeting, and a proposal must be approved by at least two-thirds of members in attendance to be passed.

2. Once eligibility for an honorary doctorate is passed, the recommendation letter, review committee meeting minutes, the name of the honorary doctorate recipient, and other related information must be presented to the University's Board of Directors; once passed by the Board of Directors, the honorary doctorate shall be conferred.

Article 5: If the recipient of an honorary doctorate is later involved in any matters that cause major damage to the University's reputation, the Honorary Doctorate Review Committee may review whether to revoke the honorary doctorate. The result shall be reported to the Board of Directors of the School for filing and approval.

Article 6: The graduation gown, certificate format, and the conferral ceremony for the honorary doctoral candidate shall be separately established.

Article 7: In principle, the honorary doctorate degree award ceremony shall be held in collaboration with the School's graduation ceremony.

Article 8: This Regulation is adopted by the University Affairs Meeting, submitted to the Board of Directors for the record, promulgated for implementation by the President and the same shall apply to its amendments.
