Article I. The Regulations are formulated to attract outstanding graduate students to study in CJCUC and improve the quality of our students.

Article II. Application eligibility:

1. The graduates of our school this year.
2. Only one option may be selected.

(1) Any student who has participated in CJCUC's master's program screening examination or admission examination for the current academic year and is accepted as a general student. At the same time, the student has also been accepted as a general student in the following master's programs' recruitment, and the programs must have acceptance rates at 30% or less for the current academic year, but has chosen to study in CJCUC.

(2) Graduated with the top three in the class (The graduates of our school this year. Including students with excellent grades who are allowed to graduate early, Deferred students who delay graduation for a semester or two, Students who are eligible for graduation after the summer study, etc. included in the ranking) interview for our Master's programme, Entrance examination was admitted as a general student, NT\$20,000 per semester after enrollment, Issued to at most four semesters. If there are less than three applicants for the graduating class, can be recommended by the student's department, The students who are supplemented to the fifth place in the class according to the ranking, Each class is still limited to three.

Article III. Application time: Shall be announced after the beginning of each academic year.

Article IV. All graduate students who meet any one of the provisions of Article II may submit an application with the following documents to the Extracurricular Activities Section of the Office of Student Affairs Office within the deadline:

- (1) Application form
- (2) The original copy of the acceptance letter for the relevant master's program.
Students who meet the qualifications of Article II, Paragraph 1 must also attach the original copy of the certificate of acceptance rate of the recruiting school (institute) 【request the certificate from the recruiting school (institute), or obtain other available supporting documents】.
- (3) The original copy of the acceptance letter for the relevant master's program.

Students who meet the qualifications of Article II, Paragraph 2 must also attach a certificate of pending graduation from CJCUC.

(4) Photocopy of graduation certificate.

(5) Original copy of undergraduate transcripts (the graduation grade and class ranking must be indicated by the school).

Article V. Those who are delaying their enrollment, on leave of absence from school, withdrawing from school, transferring to another school, or whose score after enrollment is less than 80 points on an average academic performance in each previous semester, or who have been issued two or more minor demerits shall be disqualified from the award.

Article VI Those receiving this scholarship shall not apply for other scholarships in CJCUC (except for the Excellent Conduct and Learning Scholarship). During the study period, students who voluntarily apply for leave of absence from school, withdrawal from school or transfer to another school shall repay the full amount of the scholarship already received; otherwise CJCUC shall not issue the certificate of leave, withdrawal or transfer (students who have completed two academic years of study shall not be subject to this provision).

Article VII. The Regulations are announced and implemented upon approval by the CJCUC Scholarship, Grants and Work Study Award Review Committee and the University President; the same shall apply to amendments.
