Precautions for evacuation drills on National Disaster Prevention Day

Date: September 21, 2020 (Monday)



Purpose:

To match the “National Disaster Prevention Day ” of the Executive Yuan, which simulates what happens during a large-scale earthquake.

All anti-disaster systems should be activated, and **students and teachers should cover themselves in a minute: Drop, Cover, and Hold On. By** doing so, students and teachers are able to build correct anti-earthquake concept and to save one another during an earthquake at the first minute, so as to make the campus, students, and teaching staff safe at all time.



Drill Plan:

To enable students to save one another in a severe earthquake and to enhance their situation-handling ability.

- 1) A speech on the drill plan and anti-disaster common senses is delivered for all class staff on September 14, 2020.
- 2) National Disaster Prevention Day of Earthquake Evacuation Drill on September 21, 2020.**

Earthquake striking (Broadcasting is used to start the campus earthquake drill)



Tips for the Drill — 1

1. Time: 11:30 A.M. (Earthquake striking)

2. Broadcast Contents : Earthquake! Earthquake striking! All students and teaching staff, please cover yourselves on site immediately!

3. Vital tips:

Indoors : Cover and look after one another based on the rule of “Drop”, “Cover”, and “Hold On”. It is highly recommended that you hold the table by the legs; also, make sure that you are completely under the table.



Tips for the Drill – 2

1. Time: 11:31 A.M. (Earthquake pauses)

2. Broadcasting:

Earthquake pausing! All students and teaching staff, now please evacuate to respective evacuation points! A full and detailed name call will be carried out. Make sure your heads are well protected!

3. Vital tips:

Evacuate to the designated places, carefully count numbers of students who survive the earthquake, and report them back to the Military Room.



NOTE :

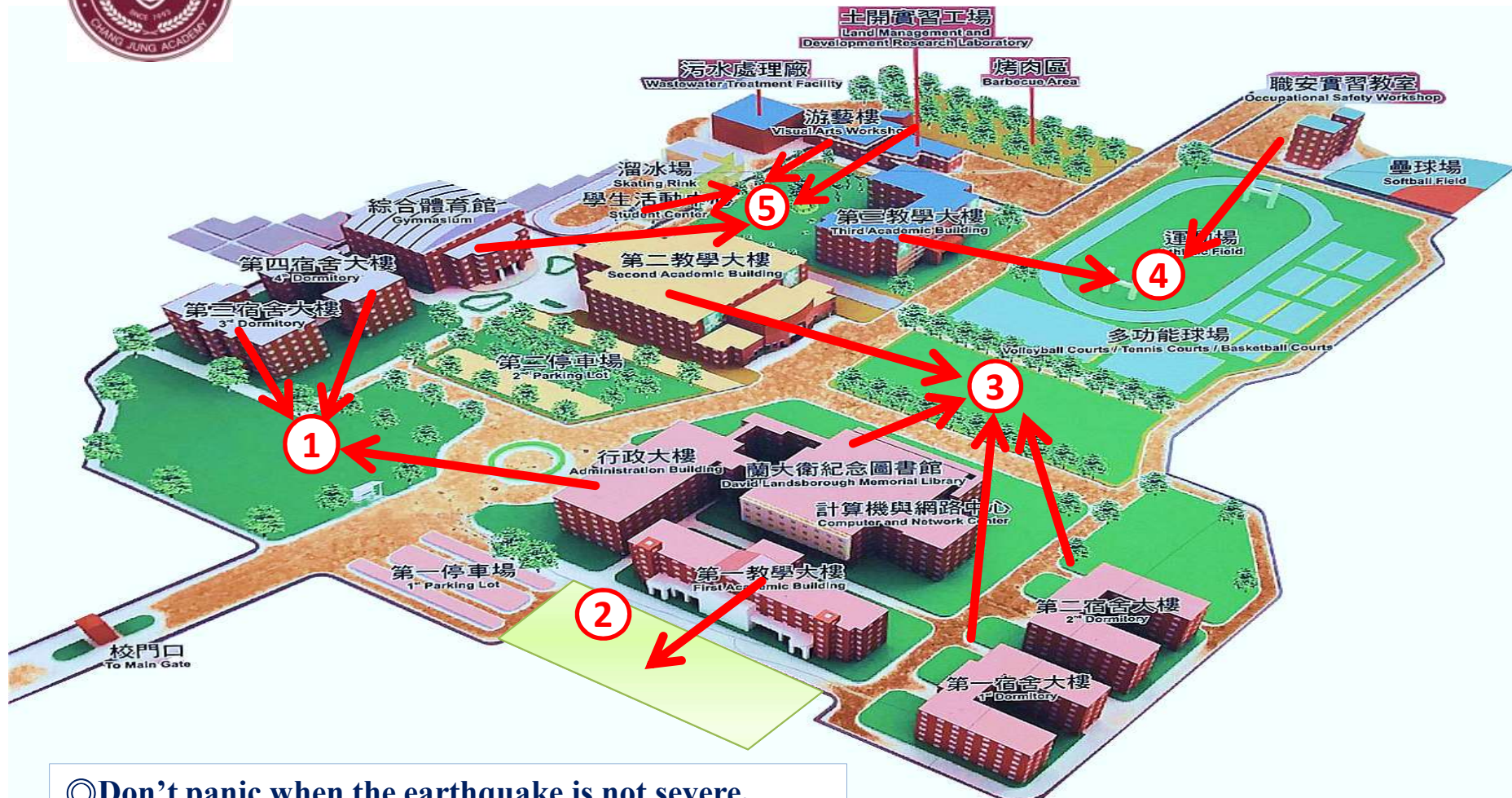
- 1) Protect your head and neck with **protective headgears** and/or **light backpacks**.
- 2) Gather at evacuation points with the aid of evacuation instructors **without pulling, running, and talking**.
- 3) Gather at designated places **with the whole class members** . (You can put away your head protection gears if gathering outdoors)
- 4) Teachers, please carefully count the numbers of students, and finish the security report grade by grade. (The Registration and Curriculum Section offers information of classes of the day.)
- 5) Students with special needs should find suitable staff in advance, in order to finish the drill safe and sound. During the drill, evacuation instructors should carefully offer suitable assistance for evacuation.

※As for the disabled students whose classrooms are on the second floor or more, their class teachers should ask 2 classmates to accompany them at the classrooms, instead of gathering with the rest of the class.

◎ Don't panic when the earthquake is not severe, cover yourselves on site instead.
◎ After the earthquake pauses, All personnel please evacuate based on the routes of → .
Numbers should be reported back to the report point of respective evacuation points.

- ①: Grass of 3rd Dormitory in the North
- ②: Empty areas next to the 1st Parking Lot
- ③: Soccer Area
- ④: Athletic Field
- ⑤: Grass in front of Student Center

Time: **12:00 P.M.** End of the Earthquake Drill

Vital tips:

Staffs go back to the office, and students can starting dining after the number reports to Military Room.
