2026 Exchange Program Application Guidelines

For more details on the application, please contact the person in charge at your university.

Requirements

- Applicants must be full-time students at a university that has a student exchange agreement with Kyoai Gakuen University (hereafter referred to as "KGU") and must maintain that status during their study abroad period.
- Applicants who have Japanese language proficiency at JLPT N2 level or higher, or an equivalent level.
 - * Acceptance will be evaluated based on the results of the designated online Japanese language test, the online interview, and the documents submitted.
- Applicants should demonstrate strong academic performance, good character, and sound physical and mental health.
- Applicants must submit all required documents by the specified deadline.
- Applicants must agree to follow KGU's rules and regulations, complete the required coursework, and actively participate
 in university activities.
- Applicants are expected to contribute to international exchange activities both on campus and within the local community.
- Applicants must follow the dormitory rules and regulations and cooperate with other residents.
 - *Students who do not follow the rules may have their scholarship reduced or suspended, or may be dismissed from the program.

Duration

From April 2026 to February of the following year

Curriculum

- 11 courses each in the first and second semester
 - * Courses include a required Japanese language class, and elective courses designated by KGU



Students are also expected to take part in designated events, such as the welcome party, Japanese speech contest, and other cultural activities.

Fees

- 1. Tuition and dormitory fees are waived.
- 2. Students are required to pay the cost of the designated student insurance, "GAKKENSAI" (Student Education and Research Accident Insurance), 12,840 yen.
- 3. Students are required to pay for Japanese National Health Insurance (approximately 2,000 yen per month), as enrollment and payment are mandatory for residents living in Japan
- 4. Students are responsible for covering personal living expenses. (including food, entertainment, and textbooks)
- 5. KGU will arrange and cover the cost of transportation from the airport to the dormitory upon arrival. (The transportation to the airport upon return is to be arranged and paid for by the student.)

Scholarship

- 70,000 yen will be provided by KGU as support for round-trip ticket expenses.
 - *The amount will be reduced by the cost mentioned in point 1, and the remaining amount will be given upon arrival.
- A monthly allowance of 5000 yen will be provided for educational support by KGU from April to January of the following year.

Housing

Exchange students live in the international dormitory, which is arranged in a shared house style. All residents are expected to cooperate in cleaning rooms and shared facilities, and in managing garbage disposal. The dormitory is shared by exchange students from our partner universities around the world and Japanese student resident assistants who help manage dorm life.

Common area: Kitchen, Refrigerator, Microwave, Cooking appliances, Cutlery, Dishes, TV, Shower, Toilet,

Washing Machine, Washroom, Wi-Fi, Heating and air conditioning

Private room: Single bed, Bed linens, Desk, Shelf, Closet, Heating and air conditioning

Other: Bicycle.



2026 年度 交換留学生募集要項

以下の内容で、交換留学生の募集を行います。申込や手続きの詳細は、所属大学担当者に確認して下さい。

条件

- 共愛学園前橋国際大学(以下、本学という)と学術交流協定を締結している大学の正規学生であり、留学期間中もその資格が維持されること
- 日本語能力試験 2 級(JLPT N2)以上または、それに相当する日本語能力があること ※受入の可否は、本学が指定するオンライン日本語テストと面接、提出書類で判定します
- 学業成績・人物ともに優秀であり、心身ともに健康であること
- 本学の指定する必要な書類などを期日までに提出すること
- 本学の規定を守り、指定する科目を履修・聴講し、指定する活動などに参加すること
- 本学ならびに地域の国際交流の推進に積極的に協力すること
- 寮の規則を守り、他の居住者と協力して生活すること

※規定を守らない場合、奨学金の減額・停止や放校などの厳しい処分がなされます

2026年4月から翌年2月まで

費用

- ① 本学の授業料、寮費の支払いは免除されます。
- ② 本学が指定する学生保険「学生教育研究災害傷害保険」の費用 12,840 円は留学生が支払います。
- ③ 国民健康保険料(月額約2,000円)は、留学生が支払います。 ※3 か月以上日本に滞在するすべての人は、国民健康保険への加入が義務となります。
- ④ 食費、娯楽費、教科書など、個人的生活費は留学生が支払います。
- ⑤ 到着時、空港から寮までの移動は本学が手配し、費用は本学が負担します。帰国時は各自で手配して支払います。

奨学金

- 往復航空券費用などの補助として 70,000 円を支給します。※上述費用の②を差し引いた金額を来日後に支給します。
- 学修などの補助として、4月から翌年1月まで毎月5,000円を支給します。


滞在

交換留学生は国際寮に住みます。この寮はシェアハウスのような形で、共有設備や部屋の掃除、ゴミ出しなどの管理を全員で協力 して行います。本学が協定を結ぶ世界各国の大学から来た交換留学生と、寮を管理する日本人学生が一緒に生活します。

Experience authentic Japanese student life in a calm, comfortable setting, with big-city excitement always within reach.








Lead of the Example 1 Housing Details
