Kindai University was founded in 1925. Now one of Japan's largest universities, it has six campuses in western Japan and boasts research facilities across the nation - from Hokkaido in the north to Kagoshima in the south. Currently, Kindai University comprises 15 faculties with 49 departments, 11 graduate schools and 1 transdisciplinary graduate school, 18 research facilities, two junior colleges, 18 associated primary and secondary schools, and two teaching hospitals. The university has over 30,000 students and more than 550,000 alumni.

Application

NOMINATION DEADLINE

- **1st Semester:** End of September
- **2nd Semester:** End of February

STUDENT APPLICATION DEADLINE

- **1st Semester:** End of October
- **2nd Semester:** End of March

LENGTH OF THE EXCHANGE PERIOD

One academic year or one semester

ELIGIBILITY

- Those who have foreign nationality
- Those who will not graduate or complete their degree program at their home institution before the end of the enrolment period of the exchange program at Kindai University (*1)
- Undergraduate and graduate students (*2)

SEMESTER DATES

- **1st Semester:**
Early April to Early August
- **2nd Semester:**
Mid September to Early February

TRANSCRIPT ISSUANCE PERIOD

- **1st Semester:** End of August
- **2nd Semester:** End of February

*An official transcript will be sent by email.

(*1) A student who is scheduled to graduate from their home university during the exchange period can still apply if they are have been accepted to their home university's postgraduate course program. In this case, we will require the submission of a letter of admission to the postgraduate program.

(*2) Please note that graduate students can participate in our program but can register only for undergraduate level courses.



Housing etc.

ACCOMMODATION

Kindai University will arrange an off-campus accommodation for exchange students.

Further information will be announced to applicants.

Housing Fee: Approximately 500,000 yen per semester

*Payment method is by credit card only.

INSURANCE

All exchange students are required to enroll in the insurance designated by Kindai University.

This insurance provides comprehensive coverage in the event of an emergency during their stay in Japan.

Details on how to apply/pay will be provided during the application.

*Additionally, purchasing travel insurance twice, firstly to cover your flights and travel before the official exchange program start, and secondly to cover your flights and travel after the official exchange program end is strongly recommended.

VISA

Students are responsible for applying for their visa before entering Japan.

Can I only take courses related to my major?

Kindai does not restrict the fields of study for course selection. Program A students can take courses from List A across multiple disciplines. Program B students can take courses from List B in the same way. Additionally, due to visa regulations, you must take at least seven courses per semester.

How many ECTS credits is one credit at Kindai University equivalent to?

1 credit at Kindai is considered equivalent to 2 ECTS credits. However, the method of credit transfer calculation may vary depending on the partner institution, so please make sure to confirm with your home university.

No, we do not accept free mover (fee paying) students.

Kindai Short-Term Japanese Program

Kindai University provides a short term Japanese language/culture program for the students who are currently attending our partner universities.

The program is distinctive in the way that it consists of interaction with Kindai University students and hands-on Japanese traditional culture experiences incl. Budo, the Japanese martial arts.

The Japanese language course is also peculiar in the sense that various levels are available, from elementary level without no learning experience to intermediates.





Route Map to Kindai University's Main Campus






Area Map
