

Chang Jung Christian University Overseas Student Scholarship and Application Regulations

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Article I. The Regulations are formulated to encourage outstanding overseas students to apply for admission and complete their studies at the University, and encourage and assist overseas students in their life in Taiwan, thereby promoting the internationalization of the University.

Article II. The “overseas students” referred to in the Regulations are foreign students and overseas Chinese students (including Hong Kong and Macao students, but excluding Mainland students) who meet the requirements of the Ministry of Education's regulations for overseas student status.

Article III. Requirements for enrolled students are as follow:

1. Eligibility for enrolled students:
 - (1) Applicants must be overseas students who have completed at least one semester of study at Chang Jung Christian University.
 - (2) Applicants must be undergraduate students in their fourth year or below, or master's students in their second year or below. Doctoral students are not eligible.
2. Applicants must have completed the minimum number of credits required for full-time students in the previous semester, ranked within the top 20% of their class academically, obtained a conduct score of 80 or above, and have no disciplinary record.
3. Overseas students receiving the Taiwan Scholarship funded by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA), the Ministry of Education (MOE), or any scholarship funded by government-sponsored special programs or other university scholarships shall not concurrently receive this scholarship, except for the Academic Excellence Scholarship.

Article IV. Requirements for Exchange student and Dual Degree Program students:

1. Exchange student: During the period of overseas exchange, the application will be suspended, and the application qualification will be resumed in the semester after the exchange ends.
2. Dual Degree Program students: Students enrolled in a dual degree program may apply for this scholarship during the first semester after enrolling at the partner university based on their academic performance in the semester prior to departure. Scholarship eligibility after departure is limited to one additional semester.

Article V. The scholarship amount and review shall be based on the following principles:

1. Applicants who meet the eligibility requirements shall receive a scholarship of NT\$20,000 per semester. As a general principle, the scholarship shall be applied directly toward tuition and miscellaneous fees. If such fees are less than NT\$20,000, only the actual amount shall be deducted..
2. Scholarship applications shall be submitted to the Office of Global Engagement. The Office shall establish a Scholarship Review Committee to review applications in accordance with these Regulations and the documents submitted by applicants. Scholarship awards shall be granted based on these Regulations.
3. Scholarships are awarded on a semester-by-semester basis. Applicants must submit a new application each semester.

Article VI. Application Method and Deadline:

1. The application process shall be administered in conformity with the schedule announced by the Office of Global Engagement for each respective semester.
2. Download application form from the Office of Global Engagement website.

Article VII. Submit the following documents for scholarship application:

1. Scholarship Application Form.
2. One photocopy each of the student ID card, Alien Resident Certificate (ARC), and bank account information (to be attached to the back of the application form).
3. Original official academic transcript issued by the University.
4. Proof of participation in service-learning activities for university affairs or campus events at Chang Jung Christian University.

Article VIII. The scholarship quota for each academic year shall be adjusted according to the University budget.

Article IX. From the date of withdrawal or transfer, students who have received a scholarship shall lose all subsequent entitlements to such financial aid under this program and are obligated to reimburse the institution for any scholarship funds disbursed for the term in question.

Furthermore, students granted a leave of absence must similarly return any scholarship funds allocated for their absence. Scholarship eligibility may be reinstated upon the students' return and formal re-enrollment in the institution.

Article X. Scholarship students found to have forged or provided false information shall have their scholarship qualification revoked and dealt with in accordance with relevant laws and regulations.

Article XI. The Regulations are implemented upon approval by the Scholarship, Grant and Work Study Review Committee, and subsequent approval by the University President; the same shall apply to amendments.
