2021 Asia-Pacific Roots & Shoots Youth Summit General Regulations for Volunteer Recruitment

The Roots & Shoots Program is an environmental education initiative started by UN Peace Ambassador Dr. Jane Goodall in 1991. It encourages young people to take action to care for our environment, communities, and animals. Roots and Shoots clubs have no membership limits as even a few dedicated students can bring about a positive effect in their communities.

In 2014, the International Jane Goodall Association and St George's House in Windsor, UK jointly organized the International Root and Shoot Leadership Training program, also known as the Windsor Meeting. The meeting invited Roots & Shoots young people from all over the world to participate and discuss related topics and establish action plans during the eight-day gathering, which was implemented in various nations. The annual meeting has taken place for the past six years.

In 2020, we launched the first Asia-Pacific Roots and Shoots Youth Summit (online conferences adopted due to the Covid-19 pandemic) to promote cooperation among young people in the Asia-Pacific region and Chang Jung Christian University (CJCU) students. This year we will hold our second online summit.

We are now recruiting 15 young people to participate in this summer's Asia-Pacific Roots & Shoots Youth Summit. The students will take part in discussions on transnational environmental activities, with the goal of expanding an international vision concerning environmental issues. Students will undergo a pre-seminar training period to learn more about what the Roots and Shoots Youth Camp entails and will serve as preparation for the Asia-Pacific Roots and Shoots Youth Summit.
