

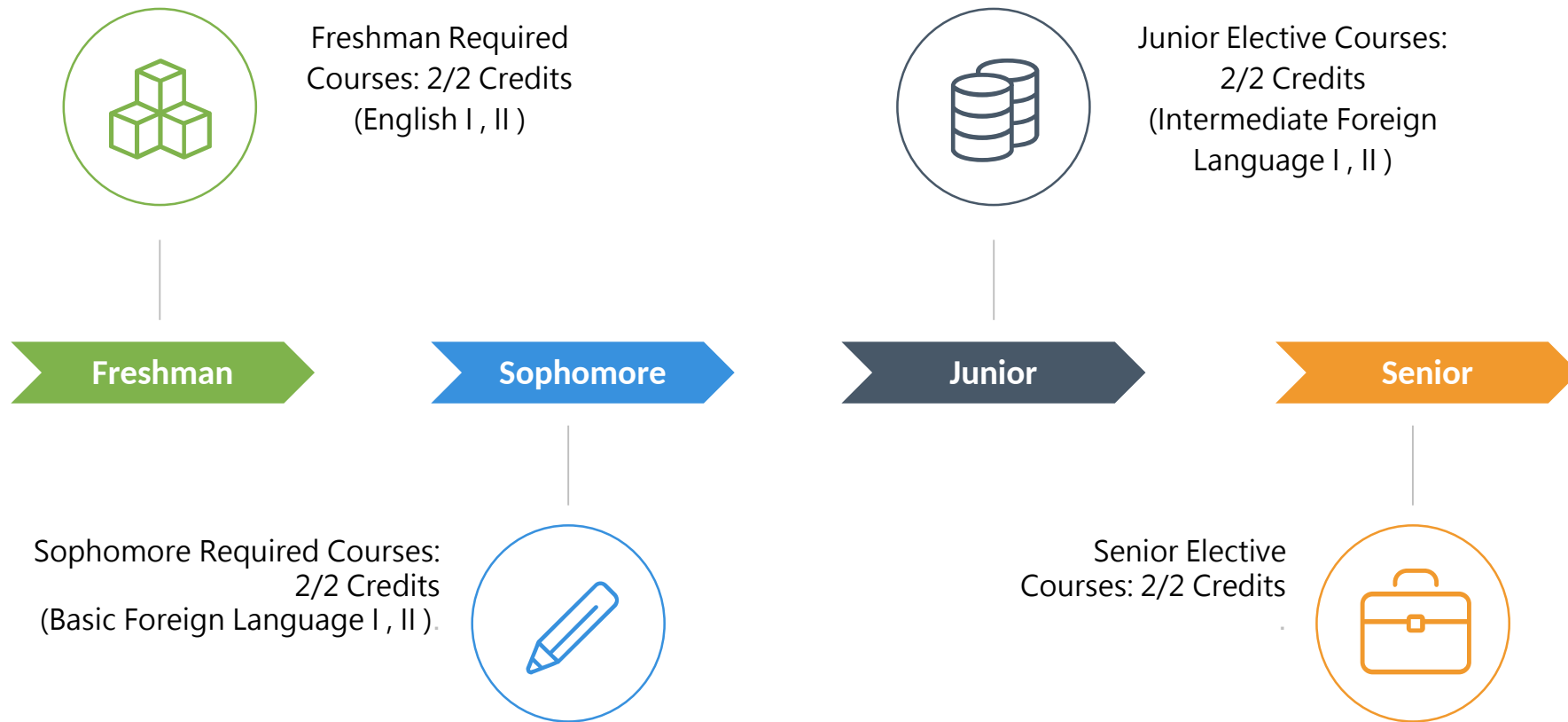

2、Required English Courses Grading System

I. Percentage Outline(for 108 Academic year students)

| Course and Grading | Midterm | Final Exam | Outside reading and others |
|---|---------|------------|----------------------------|
| Freshman (1 st Semester) 「English I」 | 25% | 25% | 50% |
| Freshman (2 nd Semester) 「English II」 | 25% | 25% | 50% |
| Sophomore (1 st Semester) 「Basic Foreign Language- English I」 | 25% | 25% | 50% |
| Sophomore (2 nd Semester) 「Basic Foreign Language- English II」 | 25% | 25% | 50% |

II. Regulation of Maximum Scores for Respective Levels

| Level | Maximum Score |
|-------|---------------|
| A | 100 |
| B | 90 |
| C | 85 |

4 、 Application for Course Exemption and Waiver



Course Exemption - With equivalent pass score on the transcript of other school

Instructions: Need to have equivalent passing score for the course subject of "English I " on the transcript of other school, to be eligible for waiving our school's common compulsory course "English I"



Course Waiver - With valid English proficiency test transcript within 2 years of enrollment.

For example : If your "TOEIC" English proficiency test meets 785, you can waive all the required English credits.



Regulation for English Course Waiver of CJC

5 、 Guideline for English Waiver Application

Application Deadline

By the end of the first week of the semester upon students' first enrollment.



Waiver Course

You can waive the required English credits based on the English proficiency test score.



Certificate

1. Obtain English proficiency Test Transcript within 2 years of enrollment.
2. Passport or ARC (for foreign students)



Application only for Freshman

1. English proficiency meets one of the standards of Waiver Regulation.
2. Official language of Foreign students is English

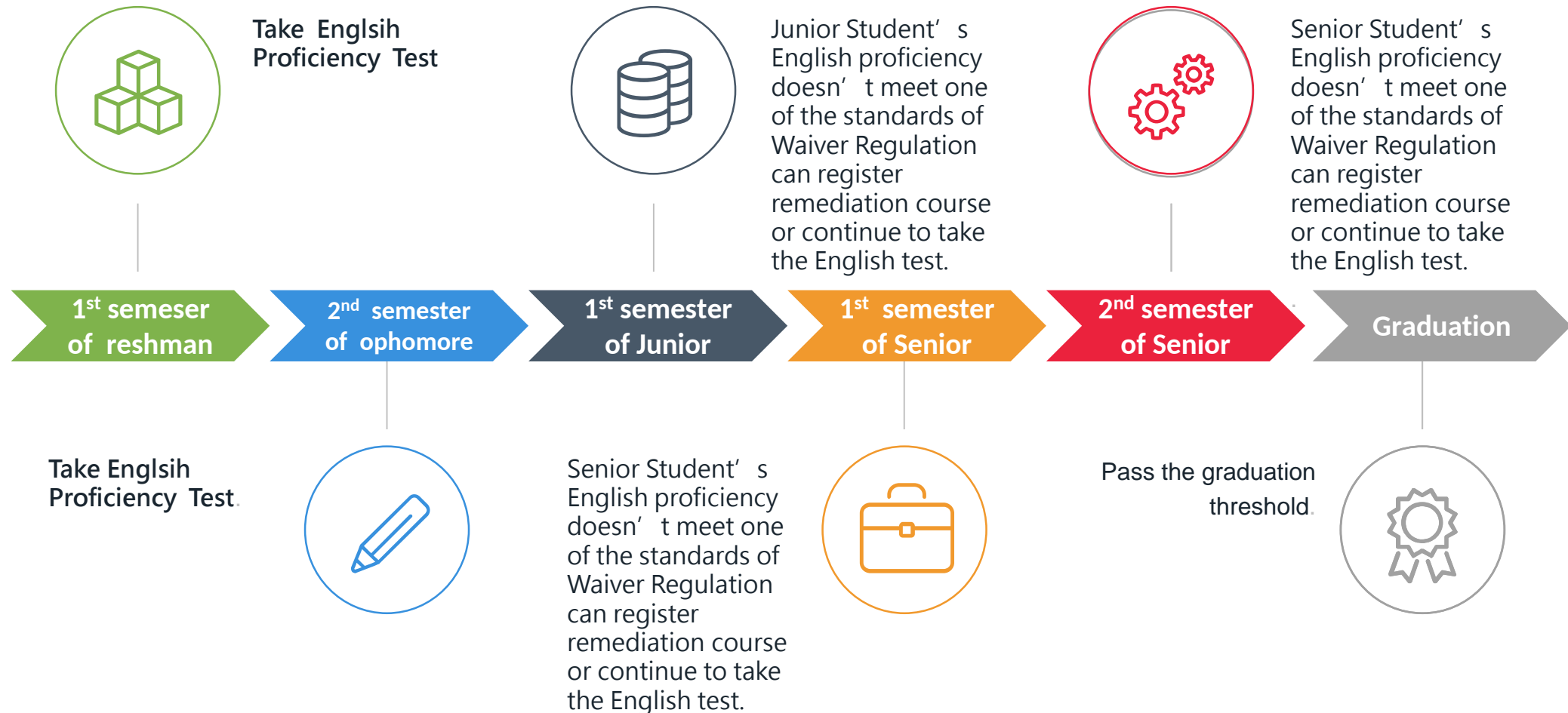
