語文中心大一「英文 I、Ⅱ」課程目標暨大綱 (113 學年度起適用)

Objectives

This course focuses on training in English listening, speaking, and reading, as well as critical thinking with an ORID framework. Students will also be led to develop strategies conducive to comprehension and vocabulary expansion. Through the instructional materials, students will be engaged with important real-life issues of the present world and prepare them for academic learning in EMI courses.

Students will thus expand their vocabulary, and improve their fluency in language usage. They are expected to use English effectively in social, educational, and professional contexts, and also become more confident in English communication and further skillful as critical readers at the end of the semester. This course also aims to integrate the 17 Sustainable Development Goals set up by the United Nations, specifically in enhancing quality education and globalization.

Course Outlines

This course, having students immersed in conversations, grammar drills, and updated reading texts on important current topics from various academic subjects, is intended to help students have further training on oral communication, effective reading strategies, and critical thinking within an ORID framework. The above skills will be developed using authentic English texts to facilitate participation in more advanced English courses or EMI courses.

At the end of this course, the students are expected to develop the core abilities as below:

- 1. The ability to apply the knowledge of language to real-life practices.
- 2. The ability to organize and integrate what they learn in class.
- 3. The ability to analyze pictures or issues within the ORID framework
- 4. The ability to think independently and solve problems.
- 5. The ability to appreciate and analyze foreign languages and cultures.
- 6. The ability to demonstrate self-study practices.
- 7. The ability to embrace global vision.
