

2026 Antibody Therapeutics Conference & The 21st Frontiers in Biomedical Sciences Conference Poster Competition

1. Purpose

The Poster Competition aims to promote academic exchange and encourage students and researchers in biomedical and life sciences fields to present their latest research findings, enhance research capabilities and promote interdisciplinary collaboration. Outstanding contributions will be recognized through a competitive evaluation process.

2. Eligibility

Applicants must meet at least one of the following criteria. Each person is limited to **one poster submission**:

- ✓ Students and Research Staff currently enrolled in or affiliated with universities nationwide, majoring in Life Sciences, Biomedicine, or related fields.
- ✓ Research Personnel in the Biomedical or Life Science sectors employed by startups founded within the last three years (on or after May 26, 2023).

3. Research Fields

Relevant areas in biomedical and life sciences.

4. Poster Competition Information

- ✓ **Phase 1: Initial Selection (Poster Presentation)**
 - **Poster Display Period:** May 26–27, 2026
 - **Venue:** Corridor outside the Chinese Restaurant, 3F, Building C, National Biotechnology Research Park (Nangang District, Taipei)
 - **Poster Size:** 90 cm (W) × 120 cm (H)
 - **Language:** English
 - **Poster Setup:** Posters must be printed and mounted by the presenters at the designated poster boards before 10:00 AM, May 26, 2026
 - **Competition Time:** [Day 1] Tuesday, May 26, 2026, 10:00 – 11:00 AM.
 - **Evaluation:** The Poster Competition Committee will evaluate submissions based on the **scientific significance, originality and innovation, potential impact / translational value**.
 - **Interaction:** Participants must be present for a Q&A session with judges (max. 3 minutes per interaction).
 - **Finalist Announcement:** The top 6 winning poster teams will be announced on the official website at 3:00 PM on Day 1. These 6 teams will **qualify for the Oral Presentation Competition the following day** and **should prepare their presentation slides in advance**.
- ✓ **Phase 2: Final Round (Oral Presentation)**
 - **Competition Time:** [Day 2] Wednesday, May 27, 2026, 10:10 – 10:40 AM. (Finalists must arrive at 9:30 AM for equipment testing).
 - **Language:** English or Mandarin.
 - **Venue:** Building C, National Biotechnology Research Park (Room C212).
 - **Format:** 5 minutes total per person (3-minute presentation + 2-minute Q&A).
 - **Awards:** Winners will be determined based on content and Q&A performance and announced

during the Closing Ceremony on Day 2.
