I. About Program

The Pre-Study Chinese Program (hereafter called “Pre-U Program”) is a language-focused, program especially offered for CJCUC’s prospective bachelor students.

Most bachelor programs at CJCUC are Chinese-taught programs. Students who would like to strengthen their language ability can join the Pre-U program with budget-friendly tuition to well prepare for future studies.

1. The Pre-U Program is a non-degree language program, which only accepts students in the Fall and Spring term enrollment.
2. There are 15 weekly hours per week, lasting 11 weeks for a term. Students take at least 2 to 4 terms before their degree program.
3. Pre-U Program accepts students who are under CEFR A2 level in Chinese language proficiency.
4. The Pre-U students still need to apply for their degree program again by themselves.
5. Students can have 1 or 2 semester tuition waivers in the freshman year after registering as bachelor students if they achieve the TOCFL Level A2 or above.

II. Eligibility

1. Applicants must be aged 18 or above.
2. Applicants meet one of the identities for the CJCUC Bachelor Degree Admission, which is one of the following:

3. Applicants have completed the high school diploma, or are graduate-on-scheduled from the high school, or qualified with R.O.C. MOE regulation on Article 2 of “Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Levels for University Admission”
4. Applicants whose Chinese proficiency level is less than CEFR A2 Level.
5. Applicants should aim to complete the Chinese-taught bachelor degree at CJCUs.
6. Applicants who are currently not awarded any of scholarships offered by the Taiwanese government, including the MOE Huayu Enrichment Scholarship, MOFA Taiwan Scholarship, MOE Taiwan Scholarship, International Higher Education Scholarship Programs of Taiwan ICDF...etc.

III 、 Important Timeline

A. Important Phases

This application guideline is for the year 2023 to 2024. The applicants will start their Pre-U Program from 2023 Fall or from 2024 Spring. Then, they will apply for the CJCUC's Degree Program of the 2024 Fall Admission.

There are three phases to undertake, including:

◆ Phase 1.: Pre-U Program

1. Office of Admissions evaluates suitable future admission channel and provides application serial number →
2. The applicants apply for the "Pre-U Program (Fall or Spring)" →
3. CLCC reviews the application. If it is qualified, admission letter for the CHINESE program is issued. →
4. Students apply for the FR visa for studying Chinese purpose →
5. Become a Chinese learner studying at CLCC →

◆ Phase 2. : Applying for a Degree Admission

7. Decide which bachelor degree program you will apply →
8. Submit the application for degree student during the assigned time →
9. CJCUC examines the qualifications, including the performance during the Pre-U studies. →
10. Admission Result: Pass or Reject →
11. The admission letters for the DEGREE program will be issued to the qualified applicants. →

◆ Phase 3.: Be the CJCUC Degree Student

12. Students whose degree program admission channel is foreign students or overseas Chinese students need to change to FS or FC visas within or outside Taiwan. →
13. Ready to be the CJCUC freshmen in 2024 Fall term admission.

IV. Quota of Numbers: 50 in maximum a year.

V. Special Offers in Tuition

1. CJCU offers special prices in tuitions, including:

- ◆ **Special offer A:** NT\$20,000 dollars per term. (The full price is NT\$33,000 dollars.)
- ◆ **Special offer B:** If the student achieves the TOCFL Level A2 or above, after being a CJCU undergraduate degree student, the tuition waiver for one or two semesters is offered. The amount of waiver is based on the length of joining the Pre-U program.

2. Those who participate in this Pre-U program, after becoming full-time degree students, will not be eligible for “Chang Jung Christian University Grants and Application Regulations for New Overseas Students”, “Chang Jung Christian University Overseas Student Scholarship and Application Regulations”, “Chang Jung Christian University Grants and Application Regulations for Specific Talent Admission and Independent

Admission Students”,and” Chang Jung Christian University Scholarship and Application Regulations for Outstanding New Students”.

3. The “*Chang Jung Christian University Overseas Student Scholarship and Application Regulations*” , “*Chang Jung Christian University Grants and Application Regulations for Specific Talent Admission and Independent Admission Students*”,and” *Chang Jung Christian University Scholarship and Application Regulations for Outstanding New Students*” can be applicable only after the “Special-offer-B” ends.
4. Awardee of the Taiwan Fellowships & Scholarships (TAFS) subsidized by R.O.C. government, such as MOE Huayu Enrichment Scholarship, MOFA or MOE Taiwan Scholarship, International Higher Education Scholarship Programs of Taiwan ICDF, will not be eligible for the special offers of the Pre-U Programs.

VI. How to Apply?

1. **Be Confirmed which identity will be used for the degree program admission by the CJCUC Office of Admissions and get a series number for the Pre-U application.**

1-1 Contact the CJCUC Office of Admissions (overseas@mail.cjcu.edu.tw)

1-2 Submit the required documents corresponding to the applicable identity.

1-3 Receive a series number issued by the Admission Office.

1-4 Here are the required document corresponding to the (5) identities.

Please be noted that the **clarity** and **validity** of the ID documents you provide is crucial for the review.

2. Please prepare the following required documents in PDF files for the online application. The documents are only accepted in English or Chinese version. If you fail to upload the files, please email to clcc@mail.cjcu.edu.tw
 - 2-1 A clear, headshot ID photo taken within three months.
 - 2-2 A photocopy of the passport information page, or ARC, or the R.O.C. ID Card. (Upload one of the above you have)
 - 2-3 High school graduation certificate or scheduled-graduation certificate.
 - 2-4 Financial statement
 - The statement needs to be issued within the past three months in English or Chinese.
 - The financial account must be in the applicant's own name and prove a balance of at least US\$2,000 or above.
 - If any sponsor to support the expenses for the applicant, please ask the person to write a guarantor letter stating the relationship, his/her willingness of supporting and the contact information of the sponsor.
 - 2-5 The Declaration Letter of Pre-U Chinese Program **【Appendix I】**. Please print out, sign, and scan it as a pdf file.
 - 2-6 Any Chinese proficiency proof document, ex. test transcript. Scan it as a pdf file.
3. Fill out the online application form: <https://forms.gle/c5WDSqnTRZbsmDHQ6> , If you have a problem uploading documents, please send those documents via email to clcc@mail.cjcu.edu.tw . CLCC will confirm the receiving via email within 3 working days.
4. It will take at least 10 working days to process the review. Please note that any unclear or questionable documents will result in a delay in review.
5. The "Letter of Registration Confirmation" will be offered when your application has been accepted.

6. The applicant will need to answer the “Letter of Confirmation” to ensure your enrollment, which will be the proof to issue the Admission Letter.
7. The visa and information of entry will be informed afterward.

VII. Fees

1. As the Pre-U students, the tuition for the Chinese Program is NT\$20,000 dollars.
2. The fees of textbooks (including material fees), student insurance, accommodation, handling fee for the consulting document applications...etc. will be charged separately. The fees in reference for the Pre-U program, please refer to the 【Appendix II】 ◦

VIII. Visa (Pre-U student vs. Degree student)

1. The Chinese language learners only can apply for the “**Visitor Visa**” (**visa code: FR**), which will be only issued 60 to 90 days. Students need to apply for an extension before the expiration, up to two times, and the longest length in total is 180 days.
2. On the condition of living in Taiwan for 120 consecutive days without leaving the country during the period, having good grades and attendance records, and intending to study Chinese language courses for more than three seasonal terms, students can apply for a “**Resident Visa**”. Then, the “**Alien Resident Certificate, ARC**” can be exchanged in the local immigration office.
3. 3. Participation in the course is a necessary consideration in applying for a visa or residence permit. Those with low attendance may be rejected by immigration.
4. If you are going to enroll as a foreign student or an overseas Chinese student, the visa must be changed to a residence visa of “**Foreign Students (visa code: FS)**” or “**Overseas Chinese Students (visa code: FC)**”. There will be two situations:
 - (1) For those who don’t hold a resident visa, they need to leave Taiwan and convert the visa for the degree study purpose (FS/FC) to enter Taiwan again.
 - (2) Those who already hold ARC can directly change their degree study visa without leaving Taiwan. For detailed regulations, please refer to the Consular Bureau of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs: <https://www.boca.gov.tw/lp-166-2-xCat-3.html>
5. The visa application should be overseas. If the application is not in the area of the original nationality, please check with the Taiwan Embassy or the TECO Office in your current area if they accept the inter-regional visa application. Sometimes you may need to apply from the area of your nationality.
6. The applicant must handle the visa application by themselves and comply with the visa application regulations of the Taiwan embassy or TECO office in the region. The admission letter does not guarantee obtaining a visa. The visa must be approved by the Bureau of Consular Affairs of the Taiwan Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The issuance of a visa does not guarantee the entry to Taiwan.

7. Chang Jung Christian University will not be a guarantor for the visa application. The visitor visa application does not include the purpose of studying Chinese in Taiwan for the people who are from the nationals of the designated countries. IX. Other Reminders

1. Based on the Taiwan regulations, no part-time job is allowed for foreigners during the first-year Chinese studying. The foreign degree students can legally work in Taiwan only if they have a work permit.
2. The Pre-U students should be responsible the application for the bachelor's degree program themselves. If any relevant supporting documents (such as transcripts, attendance records, etc.) are required, please apply to the Chinese Language and Culture in advance.
3. Being a Pre-U student is NOT guaranteed to be a CJCJ overseas degree program. The admission should be determined based on the review in that year.
4. During the period of Pre-U learning, CJCJ provides services to connect with the future department, including the academic counseling of the program and Taiwanese studying buddies for initial assistance for campus life after arrival.

X. To be the CJCJ Degree Student

1. Please fill in future admission channel and 3 priorities of the intended degree programs on the form of the "Applicant's Declaration for the Pre-U Program Registration 【Appendix I】."

Students need to prepare the application document for the program admission based on the identification (foreign students or overseas Chinese students), including the transcript and attendance record in the Pre-U Program period. The instructor's comments will also be considered for review by the department.
3. Being a Pre-U student is NOT guaranteed to be a CJCU overseas degree program. The admission should be determined based on the review in that year.
4. The application documents should be based on the admission application guideline of the degree programs announced for that academic year. The information below is for the reference:
